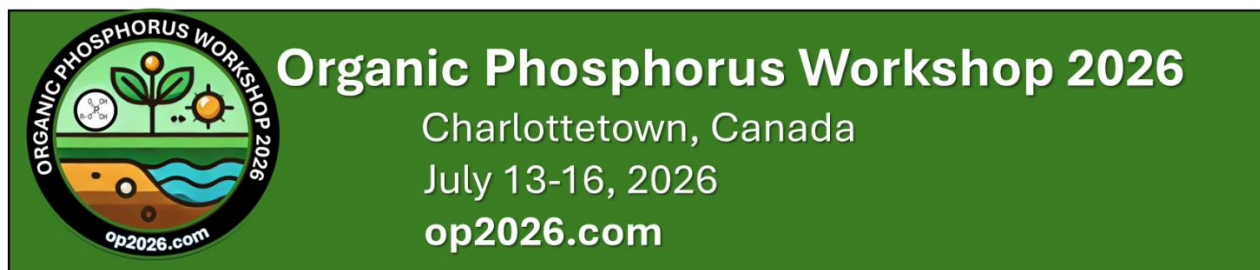


Sponsorship Prospectus
