



## Oral Presentation Instructions

### Regular Oral Presentations:

- 15 minutes: 12 minutes presentation + 3 minutes for questions

### OECD-CRP Invited Speaker Presentations:

- 20 minutes: 17 minutes presentation + 3 minutes for questions

### OECD-CRP Keynote Speakers:

- 45 minutes: 40 minutes presentation + 5 minutes for questions

### Presentation File Submission

- Presenters should either bring their presentation pptx or pdf format (standard 16:9) on a USB drive and upload it to the conference computer before their session, **or**
- Email their presentation to the organizing committee in advance at [organicphosphorus2026@gmail.com](mailto:organicphosphorus2026@gmail.com)
- Please arrive at your session room at least **10 minutes before the start of your session** and introduce yourself to the session chair.

## Poster Presentation Instructions

### Poster Dimensions

- Posters should be a maximum size of **120 cm (height) × 90 cm (width)** (portrait orientation recommended).

### Rapid-Fire Poster Presentations

- Pitch your poster! To increase visibility and stimulate discussion during the poster sessions, poster presenters are invited to give a brief rapid-fire presentation.
- Presentation Length: **1 minute**
- No questions during the rapid-fire session. Questions and discussion will take place during the poster session.
- Rapid-fire presenters should prepare **one slide only**. The slide should include the poster title, authors, affiliations, and a concise visual summary of the key message.
